






Studs



Clears & Industrial


Douglas fir clears have been used for over 200 years for appearance applications. Products have a clear finish that allows the color and grain structure to show. Today clears are used primarily for furniture, flooring, wainscoting, and trim. The strength, workability, and finishing characteristics make clears a favorite among architects, homeowners, and contractors.

Certified stock is available on most items.

Zero Waste

Nearly 100 percent of every log we process in our facilities is used. Residual wood fiber can be used to create things like plywood and particle board, pulp and paper, biofuel, and a variety of agricultural products.

Residuals

A variety of residuals (byproducts) are produced in our lumber manufacturing process. At many of our sawmills, residuals are fed back into the production process and used to fuel our kilns and dry lumber. Residuals such as bark, wood chips, and sawdust are occasionally available for purchase and pick-up at some of our mill sites.


